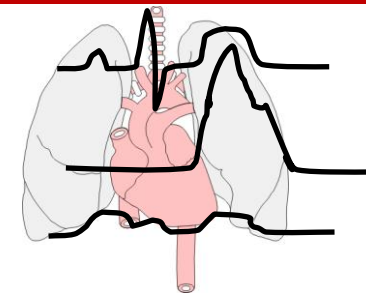

About the Workshop:

This course will provide an overview of key critical care competencies that make up the national certification examination in critical care nursing (CNCC-C). This course is of benefit to nurses or paramedics working in critical care who are seeking a review of core competencies, or who are preparing to become certified in critical care nursing.

This course is a review; participants should have some previous critical care experience (with mechanical ventilation, hemodynamic monitoring and ECG interpretation).

Concurrent Programs:

The same course is being offered at Humber River Regional Hospital, Keele Site, and St. Joseph Healthcare, Hamilton. Participants may take missed classes at the alternate location IF SPACE PERMITS. 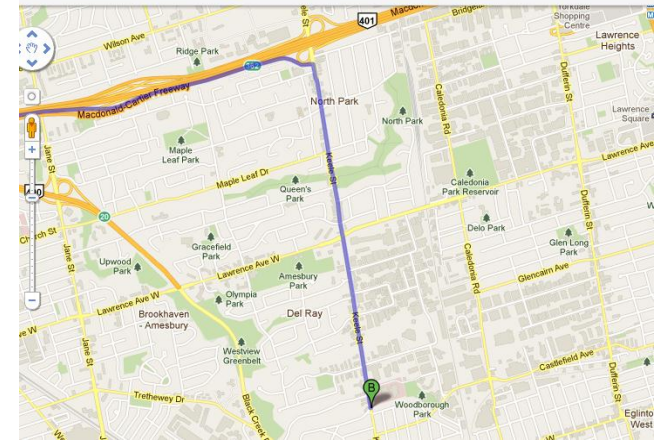
Emailed confirmation will be sent that includes the link to course handout material.

Take exit toward Keele Street/Dufferin Street/Yorkdale Rd/Allen Road from Highway 401.

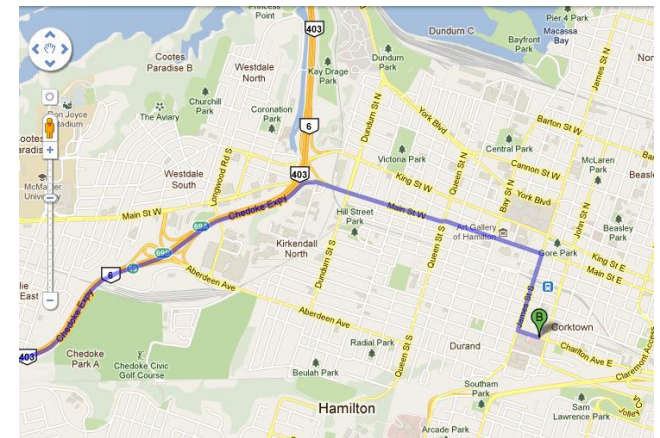
Take exit 362 for Keele Street and travel 2.8 km. Humber River Regional Hospital is located on the west side of Keele St.
